

Why did you want to be Deputy Head at MHS: Milford Haven is a big town with a fantastic history. I want to help the school pupils achieve their potential and lead successful lives.


What you love about Milford Haven: The busy town, friendly people and everyone has a great sense of humour!

#### CHRISTMAS DECORATION APPEAL:


In the coming months we have several community based events planned. One of which is a special one off festive event at the Mount Community Centre, and we would really like to decorate the centre for this special day.
