CASHLESS CATERING:

- *If you top up your child's account please be aware it can take up to 2 hours to actually credit the account– so if you do it on a Sunday night it will not show on a Monday break/ lunchtime.*
- *You can cap the amount that your child is able to spend each day, to do this just contact the school catering department at County Hall.*
- *You can also contact the school catering department at county hall and request a break down of what your child has purchased from the school canteen facility.*

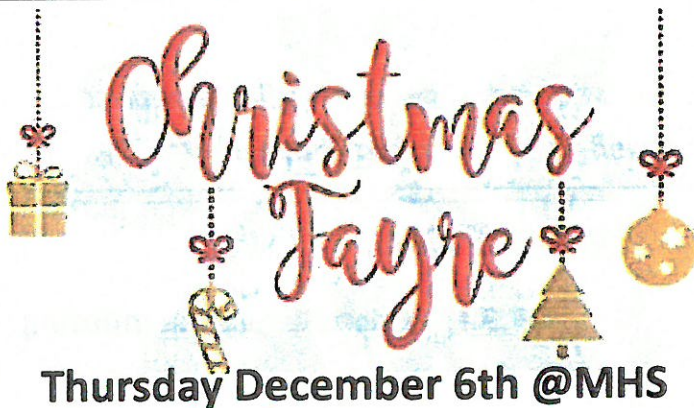
