## Re: Milford Haven Museum trip

This half term we have been learning about the rich history of Milford Haven in our literacy and topic lessons (for Conwy this happened last year). To support your son/daughters learning, on Wednesday 26th October we are going to Milford Haven Museum to meet with their curators to dive into this history in greater depth.

We think it is vitally important that pupils understand the history of our town and understand how it has shaped where we live today.

The trip will take place during lessons 1-3 so pupils are required to wear their school uniform. They do not need to bring lunch on the trip because we will be back in school for break 2. However we ask that they bring a water bottle and a snack to have whilst out of school. (They will need a lunch for when back in school but this can be purchased/eaten later in school).

There will be no charge for entering the museum however we ask for a contribution of £2.50 to cover the cost of transport to and from the museum. This payment is to be made via Pay360 (https://www.pay360educationpayments.com/Home). If you have not used Pay 360 before, you will need an access code which can be provided from school. Please request one with your child's class teacher. Please could you also return the permission slip (attached) to your son/daughters Bay teacher by Monday 24th October.

Participation in the trip will, of course, be subject to <u>positive behaviour and engagement</u> in lessons prior to the events. We appreciate your support in maintaining our values of Ready, Respect, Safe.
