## Update to uniform following the Headteacher's letter

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to update you on recent developments regarding our school uniform policy, following the feedback from the surveys conducted by our Senior Prefects.

Based on the survey responses, the school governors have decided to form a working party to thoroughly review our current school uniform policy. This review aims to address concerns and suggestions raised by both pupils and parents, ensuring that our policy continues to reflect the values and expectations of our school community.

In the interim, it has been agreed to implement a minor but significant change to the current policy regarding confiscated items. Effective immediately, any items that are not part of the school uniform and are confiscated will no longer be returned at the end of the school day. Instead, these items will be available for collection only after 1:15pm on Fridays from Steynton Hall. This change is intended to streamline the process and minimise disruptions during the school week.

We kindly ask that you discuss this important change with your child to ensure they understand and comply with the updated policy. It is crucial to note that sanctions will be imposed for any defiance or verbal abuse directed towards staff enforcing this policy.

As a reminder, parents and carers have agreed to follow the school uniform policy as part of the admission process. Your continued support in upholding this policy is greatly appreciated. The full policy can be found - here.

This change will take immediate effect from Monday 1st July.
