In this exciting issue, we're celebrating the outstanding achievements of our pupils, highlighting their successes both in and out of the classroom.

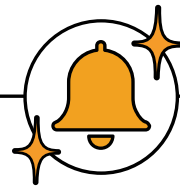
From academic milestones to artistic talent and sporting triumphs, this magazine showcases the pride and ambition that define our school community.

DigiMag pupils were delighted to secure an interview with MP Henry Tufnell who kindly came to the school for a face to face interview for our pupil-led digital magazine.



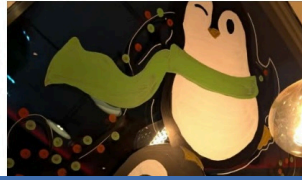
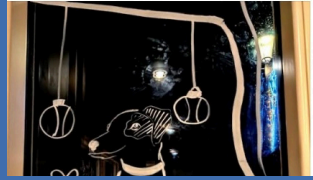
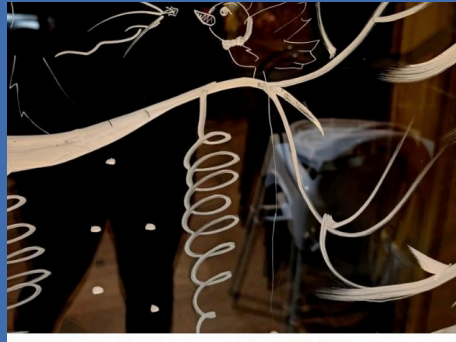
