This Term you have the challenge of completing Takeaway Home Learning which will strengthen your knowledge and earn you Learning points. The tasks are divided into levels using buttons –

Blue tasks earn you 1 button, Amber earn you 2 and Green earn you 3 buttons. Your challenge is to gain a minimum of 4 buttons over the course of your Textiles project.

All tasks must be completed and submitted by.....

1 Button tasks

Task 1: Create a collage/mood board with an explanation of how these images inspire you with your PJ's.

Use images from the internet, magazines, brochures, use keywords to help explain.

Task 2: Create a label for PJ's showing the care and washing instructions.

Task 3: Research three textile products that are recycled or made from sustainable materials

On your work explain how the product has been recycled or made from sustainable materials



BONUS Button – can you find any made by local artists or companies!

Task 4: Create a poster advertising your Pj's for sale.

2 Buttons tasks

Task 1: Produce a packaging to sell your PJ's in. The Packaging should have all the relevant information on including a worked out selling cost. It should be the right size to fit your PJ's.

Task 2: Create a comic strip on how to tie dye. Remember to include health and safety points and a list of tools and equipment you may need to use

Task 3: Compare and contrast three different PJ's designs – compare the PJ's design features / components used to fulfil their function/ consumer market / cost.. Present the work on A4 paper – you can use ICT or draw for the images.

Task 4: Create 10 – 20 challenging questions about what we have covered in the topic so far. Write the questions on a separate A4 sheet with the answers on another – Use ICT to present your work.

3 Buttons tasks

Task 1: Make something textile based at home. You can knit or sew it; you must take photographs of yourself making it. Using technical language you will need to explain the processes you have used to make. Present your work on a A2 board

Task 2: Redesign an existing product using recycled materials.

Present your work on an A2 board, you should include the original image and redesigned drawings; plus an explanation of what materials you have used and why?

Task 3: Create an information sheet or PowerPoint presentation based on a company or designer who uses recycled materials in their work.

Include some background information about the designer/company and some examples of their work.
