Studying: Maths, Biology, History and Sociology

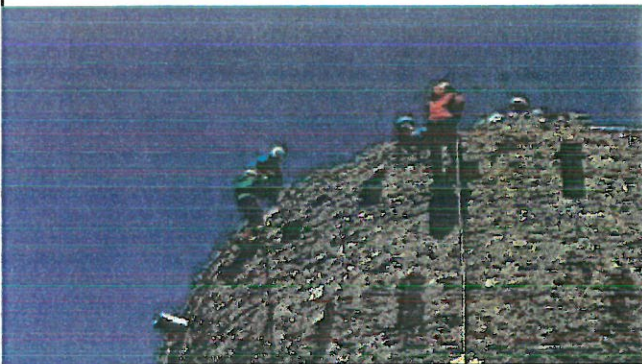
Why you wanted to be Head Girl: to make a change in the school and become a role model for younger years .

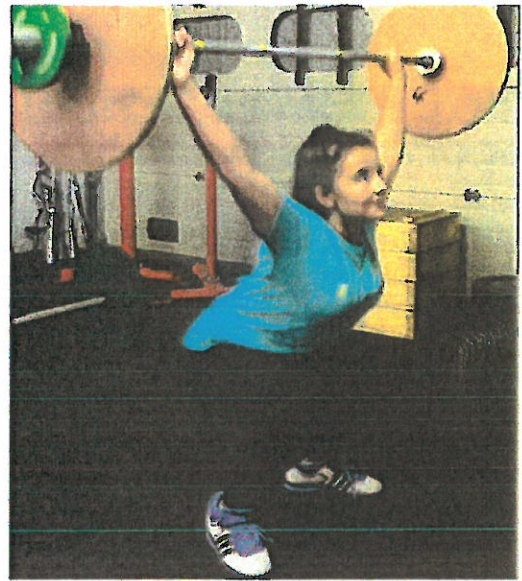
