RE: Re-purposed function of Milford Haven School.

Dear Parents & Carers,

Yesterday we sadly closed the doors of Milford Haven School, and until we announce otherwise we will not be operating as a school. On Monday we will be opening our doors, but only to provide essential childcare for the children of key workers as a last resort if it is not safe for them to be at home. School will be open for pupils from 8.30am, and we will be closing our doors at 3.10pm. Please note that we will not be allowing any pupils on school site outside of these hours. We will not be teaching 'lessons' or operating as an educational establishment over the coming weeks, as that would disadvantage those in isolation. We will be following all guidance being offered with regards to social distancing, and any children that do attend school site during this period will also be expected to abide by this guidance- failure to do so will require you to collect your child and remove them from school site.

We ask that in the interest of everyone's safety you please follow these key principles:

1. If it is at all possible for children to be at home, then they should be.
2. If a child is identified as needing specialist support, is vulnerable or has a parent who is a critical worker, then childcare NOT educational provision will be available for them.
3. Parents should not rely for childcare upon those who are advised to be in the stringent social distancing category such as grandparents, friends, or family members with underlying conditions.
4. Parents should also do everything they can to ensure children are not mixing socially in a way which can continue to spread the virus. They should observe the same social distancing principles as adults.
5. Special settings continue to care for children wherever possible.

If your work is critical to the COVID-19 response or you work in one of the critical sectors listed by the Government, and you cannot keep your child safe at home, your children will be provided with childcare provision.

Again, we cannot stress enough the importance of keeping your children within the family home wherever possible.
