Re: Return to school update and end of term arrangements.

Dear Parent/Carer,

As we come to the end of the third week back in school I would like to say how wonderful it has been to see so many of our learners here in Milford Haven School. Both staff and pupils have expressed how positive the experience has been and that they have enjoyed the opportunity to interact with others. There is now one final week left to this term, and in line with Pembrokeshire County Council policy the fourth and additional week will run from Monday July 20th to Thursday July 23rd, Friday July 24th is an INSET day so the school will be closed to all pupils.

I would like to extend my thanks to all the families who completed the google form for gathering interest in the new transition days in this last week. Your feedback has helped us to create a bespoke timetable for a two day transition experience for over 180 Year 6 learners on Wednesday 22nd and Thursday 23rd July.

Our staff will continue to support all our learners through online learning in google classrooms, as well as face to face sessions here at school for those attending, as we have done since reopening. We have also been able to secure a further face to face learning experience for all our current learners on the Monday and Tuesday of the extra week. Therefore during this week our house tutors have been in discussions with their pods and booking your son/daughter in for the following days;

Monday 20 th July	Pods 1* morning session and Pod 2 afternoon sessions for years 7 & 8 learners
Tuesday 21 st July	Pods 1* morning session and Pod 2 afternoon sessions for years 9 & 10 learners

** Note that all learners requiring school transport will be offered a place in Pod 1 only.*

Please note that in lieu of the additional week and extended summer term, the October half term holiday will be extended to two weeks, running from Monday 19th October to Friday 30th October 2020. Pupils will return to school on Monday 2nd November 2020.

Hub support for learners of key workers:
