Dear Parents & Carers,

**RE: Wearing of face coverings at school**

The Welsh Government has recently updated its guidance on the use of face coverings in schools and on dedicated school transport for year 7 and up. It is vital that you ensure your child attends school prepared with a face covering, everyone is expected to wear a face covering in areas of the school where social distancing is not possible such as the corridors and canteen area, unless they have a valid medical exemption.

To reduce the risk of transmission amongst parents and relatives, please wear masks when visiting school, and at drop-off and collection areas. Maintaining clear social distance at the school gates will also reduce risk and set a good example to pupils. Thank you to everyone that is supporting us with these safety measures in a combined effort to protect our wider community.

Along with regular hand washing/sanitising and social distancing, this will reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19 at school as far as possible.

Please follow these guidelines and encourage your child to follow theirs too, all safety measures that we ask you to adhere to at Milford Haven School have been implemented to try to keep you and your families as safe as possible. These changes are based on new advice from Welsh Government's Technical Advisory Group, as we learn more about the way COVID-19 is transmitted, and should we receive any further updated guidance we will make sure you are kept fully informed.
