As you will all be aware online learning will take place for our pupils during the first week of this new Spring term. Although the school building will be closed we will very much still be operating, but now virtually as we have done earlier this year. A summary of the week ahead:

- Monday 4th & Tuesday 5th January- the school site will be closed to all pupils and virtual learning of our COVID Curriculum will take place for all pupils in all year groups
- Wednesday 6th, Thursday 7th and Friday 8th January- virtual learning will continue, but the school site will be open to provide pre-booked places only for childcare provision if both sets of parents are key workers / critical care workers. All requests will be processed by staff on Monday January 4th, and those that request a place will be telephoned by 2pm on Tuesday January 5th.
- Friday 8th January- The scheduled external GCSE Travel & Tourism exam will go ahead for the 8 Year 11 pupils entered. Pupils should please register at the Attendance Office with Mrs Latham on arrival before and departure from the exam.
