Dear Learner,

We are looking forward to welcoming you back to school and know you will be keen to get back to the familiar routines of school.

We have received a further update circulated by Qualifications Wales (QW) relating to the assessment arrangements for GCSE, AS, A level and Skills Challenge Certificate qualifications this summer. [Link to Qualifications Wales Learner Letter](#)

The **learner letter** notes that schools have received updated guidance about how the process of determining Centre Determined Grades (CDG) will be administered and the processes involved from both Qualifications Wales and the Welsh Joint Education Committee (WJEC). However as mentioned in the letter we are awaiting the final version of the Qualification Wales guidance and further WJEC updates.

We are currently using the information we have received to design the process we will follow and will share with you more detailed information about how your centre determined grade will be generated before the Easter holidays including a clear timeline (maybe subject to change).

The next two weeks are an opportunity for you to settle back into daily school life and continue to develop your skills, knowledge and understanding in the courses you are following. In a subject where exams have been cancelled and a CDG is required your teacher may use some of the lessons over the next two weeks to help prepare you and work on evidence that may contribute to your CDG. You may also be completing Non Examined Assessments (NEAs), Welsh Bacc or elements of your vocational courses within your lesson time. Your teacher will keep you informed as the weeks continue.
