Dear Learner,

We have received a further update and guidance from the Welsh Joint Education Committee (WJEC) relating to the assessment arrangements for the following vocational qualifications in Summer 2021 similar information has been received for the small number of vocational courses we offer through the English exam boards Pearson Edexcel and OCR.

- Level 3 Applied Certificates and Diplomas
- Level 1/2 Vocational Awards
- Entry Level Certificates
- Latin Certificates
- Additional Maths

The process to determine a grade will be similar to the system we are following for GCSE, AS, A levels and Skills Challenge Certificate where a Centre Determined Grade is required.

As noted by the WJEC: "Following Qualifications Wales' confirmation that vocational qualifications offered in Wales that are also offered in England and Northern Ireland will be awarded based on **Teacher Assessed Grades (TAGs)** in line with the approach being taken in England and Northern Ireland".

However the WJEC wrote that "Although teachers may share results associated with individual pieces of evidence, **they must not share with students the grades submitted to us before results are released**".

This is different to the guidance we follow for WJEC GCSE, AS, A level and Skills Challenge Certificate where after the summer half term you will be given your provisional Centre Determined Grades (based on current guidance).
