The WJEC November 2021 Exam Series is going ahead and we have taken the decision to enter all Year 11 students for their GCSE Maths and English Language exams. Please be assured that due consideration has been given to this decision and we really do believe that this is in the best interests of your child. This will give all learners two opportunities at these key qualifications to ensure the best outcome for them.

## **External Exam Dates**

English Language – Unit 2 – Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November 9am
English Language – Unit 3 – Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 9am
Maths Paper 1 – Non-Calculator – Monday 8th November 9am
Maths Paper 2 – Calculator – Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> November 9am

In order that pupils are fully prepared, exam preparation is well underway, consolidating elements of the course which have already been delivered in years 9 and 10. In addition to this we are planning a series of mock exams to both confirm tiers of entry where applicable, along with providing learners with the experience of sitting an external exam.
